Tooth blackening and grinding is an old tradition in Vietnam, especially among ethnic groups in the Truong Son Mountains and the Central Highlands. Groups like the Cotu, Mnong, Ta Oi, S'tieng, and Brau used to grind their teeth and then color them black. This was an important step when young people became adults. It also helped protect the teeth from getting bad or infected.

The Cotu people used pebbles from streams to grind their teeth smooth. After that, they used a special tree sap to protect their teeth. The Mnong people used sap from krai trees mixed with ashes. The sap is very spicy and hurts a bit, but it makes the teeth black and strong. Boys and girls put krai sap on their teeth every night to stop tooth decay.

Tooth blackening began to disappear in the 1950s because tooth grinding caused health problems like infections and bleeding. It is no longer common in most parts of Vietnam. However, some Lao and Lu people in the Northwest, like in Hon Hamlet, Lai Chau Province, still keep this tradition. In some villages and during festivals, some older people and women at festivals still proudly show their black teeth as a symbol of beauty. It is also linked to an old belief that looking like buffalos, which are strong and sacred animals to many groups, was a good thing.
