In the 21st century, the relationship between humans and the environment has become more important than ever. With over 8 billion people on Earth, human activity now affects the planet on a global scale. Climate change, deforestation, pollution, and the loss of biodiversity are some of the biggest environmental problems today. Scientists **warn** that if we don't change the way we live, we may face more natural disasters, food shortages, and rising sea levels.

Many of today's environmental problems are caused by human actions. Burning fossil fuels for energy increases the amount of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere, leading to global warming. Cutting down forests for farming or building reduces the number of trees that can absorb carbon dioxide. Small changes—such as using reusable bags, saving electricity, eating less meat, or planting trees—can have a big impact when millions of people do them. Technology also helps by providing apps and devices that track energy use or suggest eco-friendly choices. By combining efforts from both governments and individuals, there is hope for a more sustainable future.

Protecting Traditional Music

[I] Traditional music plays a vital role in preserving a nation's cultural heritage. It reflects the history, beliefs, and daily lives of past generations. However, in the modern world, globalisation and the popularity of international pop music have caused a significant **decline** in the appreciation of traditional music forms. More and more young people are turning away from their musical roots, favouring contemporary genres over traditional ones.

[II] There are many reasons why traditional music is losing ground. One important factor is the lack of media coverage; television and radio channels often prioritise modern music, leaving little space for traditional songs. Another reason is the migration of young people from rural areas, where traditional music is often preserved, to urban centres. Cultural festivals are organised to provide traditional musicians with platforms to perform and gain recognition. [IV] Protecting traditional music is essential, not only for preserving cultural diversity but also for fostering a sense of identity and pride among citizens. **Without intervention, many unique musical forms could disappear forever.** Therefore, it is crucial that societies invest in education, media promotion, and community activities to ensure that traditional music continues to thrive in a rapidly changing world.
